Counting Change

When you buy an item, you might not have the exact coins and banknotes for the amount it costs. You can then pay with a bigger banknote, and get back some change.

To give change, or to check the change you are given, <u>count up</u> from *the price* of the item until you reach the amount the customer gives.



Count up from R2,75 until R5 →



720
